You indemnify FELK Engineering in respect of such loss or damage. You also agree the that Extra Bailed Goods may be stored, stationary, moved or in transit, including on public roads and at third party facilities.

FELK Engineering recommends that You obtain insurance for the Extra Bailed Goods and the circumstances set out in clause 12 of the Terms or that other arrangements are made for the storage of the Extra Bailed Goods.

The above information regarding Extra Bailed Goods and the limitation of liability in clause 12 of the Terms does not replace the Terms and FELK Engineering recommends You read the Terms in full.
